## REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR

CS03: Consulting services for unique health identifier and electronic personal health record design and implementation

## (Re-advertisement)

- The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) has received a Loan and Grant from the Asian Development (ADB) towards the cost of Greater Mekong Subregion Border Areas Health Project (GMS-BAHP) executed by the Ministry of Health.
- 2. The Ministry of Health intends to apply a portion of these loans and grants for engaging national consulting firm for unique health identifier and electronic personal health record design and implementation. The consulting firm is expected to mobilize in May, 2026 and cover for a period of 24 months with minimum inputs of 6 personmonths for international experts and 39 person-months for national experts.
- 3. The main objectives of the consulting service are to (i) demonstrate the use of UHI and biometrics identification for health systems integration and continuity of care, and identify lessons learned (UHI system); (ii) demonstrate the use of electronic personal health record ("ePHR") for migrant workers and identify lessons learned (ePHR mobile application); and (iii) demonstrate the use of electronic personal health record ("ePHR") systems for pilot patient recording (ePHR system).
- 4. The Ministry of Health now invites interested national consulting firm who is suitably qualified and experienced, to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) for the said consulting service. The consultant selection will be Quality- and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) method as described in the ADB Procurement Policy, Procurement Regulations for ADB Borrowers, and User's Guide on the Selection of Consulting Services for Borrowers.
