**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST
FOR
CS 02: CONSULTING SERVICES FOR BASELINE AND MID TERM SURVEY
(EXTENSION)**

1. The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) has received a Loan and Grant from the Asian Development (ADB) towards the cost of Greater Mekong Subregion Border Areas Health Project (GMS-BAHP) executed by the Ministry of Health.
2. The Ministry of Health intends to apply a portion of these loans and grants for engaging national consulting firm for Baseline and Mid Term Survey Consultancy. The consulting firm is expected to mobilize in December, 2024 and cover for a period of 6 months (3 months for baseline survey and 3 months for midterm survey) with minimum inputs of 4 person-months for international experts and 19 person-months for national experts.
3. The main objectives of the consulting service are to undertake (i) Baseline Survey and (ii) Mid Term Review in Project targeted Area. The baseline survey will establish project baseline values for indicators listed in design and monitoring framework and gender action plan. The survey will also assess other baseline measures as proposed by the Ministry of Health, as the project Executing Agency. The mid-term review (MTR) will assess project implementation progress at the 30-month stage. The MTR will assess both implementation process and progress towards outputs. The MTR will provide recommendations for any revisions required to the project including but not limited to (i) implementation approach, (ii) activity design and scheduling, (iii) financial allocations and costings, (iv) design and monitoring framework, and (v) gender action plan.
4. The Ministry of Health now invites interested national consulting firm who is suitably qualified and experienced, to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) for the said consulting service. The consultant selection will be Least-Cost Selection (LCS) method as described in the ADB Procurement Policy, Procurement Regulations for ADB Borrowers, and User's Guide on the Selection of Consulting Services for Borrowers.
